Dahr Jamail is an independent, unembedded journalist who has spent a total of 8 months in occupied Iraq. He is one of the very few independent US journalists in Iraq. His reports have been published in The Nation, The Sunday Herald and Islam Online and his dispatches and news stories have been translated into Polish, German, Dutch, Spanish, Japanese, Portuguese and Arabic. On the radio, he is a correspondent for Flashpoints and reports for the BBC, Democracy Now!, and numerous other stations around the globe.
