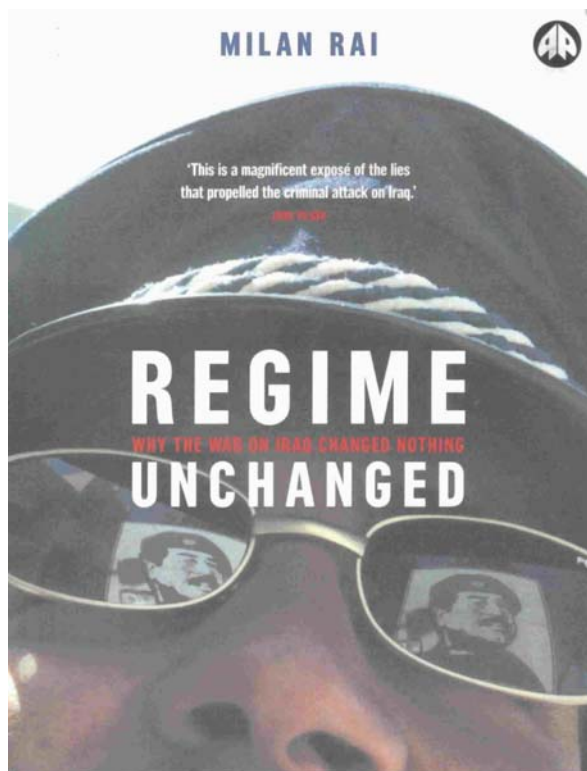


# UK Author Milan Rai to speak in Seattle
